



Sydney Worlds transportation news

Dear Sydney Sailors here's your container captain's news.

Please find enclosed final proposal for transport of the european FD's to and from sydney. Although the tariffs are fixed now, the final prices for each sailor will depend on the exact numbers of competitors, which is not fully clear to me yet. Prices mentioned in the list enclosed are based on that what I know now regarding competitors.

Request to all is to confirm to me by email (use only this adress, reply is ok: frank.nooijen@ziggo.nl) as soon as possible within one week that you will be participating in the transport and check if all boats known are on the list and also if boats are definitively not participating. Within one week from now I will come with the final prices for each boat. So you will get an email in person with your exact payment figure! Please no money wiering before you received this email.

Final container tariffs are:

- transport Oss-Sydney-Oss, all included, except insurance if needed: 7.500,- euro/container, max 6 boats
- sponsoring IFDCO 1250,- euro/container
- additional transport Oss-Berlin-Oss 1500,-

- euro/trip, 2x = 3000,-euro/container
- additional transport
 Oss-Zsambek (Hu) Oss 3050,- euro/trip,
 2x = 6100,- euro/container
- additional transport
 Oss-Dervio (It)-Oss
 2450,- euro/trip, 2x =
 4900,- euro/container

In case of full containers costs per container can be split by 6 boats. Costs of empty spaces to be devided by all participants. Costs for the additional transport for the account of the specific users. See preliminary list enclosed, based on information known now.

Please fill in the known ATA carnet list enclosed as before and send this to me on short notice: do only use this excel sheet format and send in only as excel sheet for further processing. All valuables taken there and back must be on the list. no food-stuff please, that is stricktly forbidden.

Will come back on short notice with a transport insurence proposal as before for all who might need that. Please check your policy, many do not cover overseas transport. Most likely premium will be 0,5% as before. Value to be defined individually.

For the whole loading and transport proces I have the following proposal regarding

time frames: there is still some flexibility:

- for the sea transport we base ourselves on ETD Rotterdam 11 nov and ETA sydney 19 dec, that means that participating in the Australian Nationals will be possible for those who are interested
- loading Oss preferably at saterday 1st november
- loading Berlin wednesday 29th October
- loading Hungary tuesday 28th October
- loading Italy tuesday 28th October

Please let me now your prefered date & place of loading.
