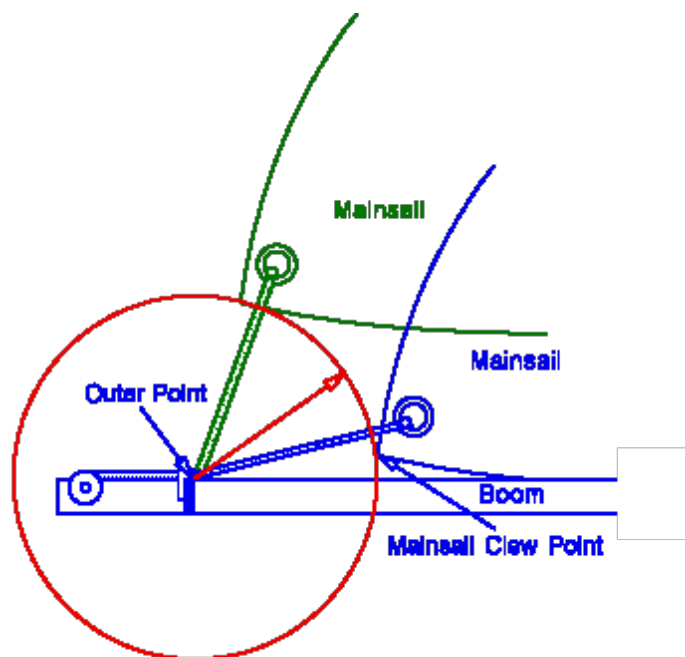


Rule 72, explained



**Outer Point to Mainsail Clew Point
Less than 60 mm**

This rule then requires a physical stop, i.e. the strap (as is the case for mainsails in a foot groove) which prevents the clew of the sail being rigged beyond the outer point, but also restricts the mainsail clew from flying free more than 60 mm from the outer point on the boom.
