Grouping of World Sailing International Measurers 2020-2021

The World Sailing grouping system has the purpose:

- to encourage International Measurers to participate in an International Measurers seminar and to take the exam;
- to identify International Measurers that World Sailing can appoint to major World Sailing (multi-class) events and Olympic Class championships.

International Measurers in group 2 may be appointed as multi-class event Equipment Inspectors. International Measurers in group 1 may be appointed as Chief Equipment Inspectors for various World Sailing events, in addition to group 2 appointments.

Multi -class event Chief Equipment Inspector (1c); Combined Olympic Class Worlds Chief Equipment Inspector or Olympic ITO (1b); or Technical Committee (Vice-)Chair of the Olympic Sailing Competition (1a).

Group 1a includes 1b & 1c;

Group 1b includes 1c.
